## Everything you need to know about Erasmus +

Erasmus + is the flagship mobility programme launched by the European Commission.

For the academic year 2016/2017 and 2017/2018 Erasmus+ offers opportunities not only for **students**, but also for **staff**. Merging seven earlier programmes, it provides opportunities for a wide variety of individuals and organisations.

The Erasmus+ programme key actions involve International Institute of Management IMI-NOVA and TUKE, the Technical University of Kosice (Slovakia):

## INTERNATIONAL CREDIT MOBILITY

Under the International Credit Mobility Project (KA107), IMI\_NOVA and TUKE offers grants for students as well as teaching and training staff. These grants are financed by the European Commission under the Erasmus+ Programme and will contribute towards travel costs and subsistence allowance.

International Credit Mobility concerns IMI\_NOVA students and staff has with TUKE Kosice an Erasmus+ KA107 agreement.

### **SELECTION CRITERIA AND PROCEDURES:**

#### **Requirements:**

1. To have PhD or equivalent and to be IMI-NOVA permanent staff;
2. have participated to min. 3 International conferences;
3. To know 1. English or 2 French language (C1 or B2)
4. To have published 1 or more articles in foreign languages

**A committee, appointed by the Rector, will assess the applications of the teachers / researchers on the basis of:**

1. **Requirements (see above)**
2. **training or teaching activity or collaborative project**, which began with the host universities and on the basis of a 'equitable distribution among the scientific areas.

The Commission will prepare the ranking of teachers / researchers and winners of suitable candidates, which will be published on the IMI-NOVA web pages for the Internationalization.

The credits must be acquired in respect of any existing constraints introductory provided by law and Erasmus+ project.

The winners and suitable candidates' lecturers/professors/researchers will be required to declare their willingness to accept the intended destination, in this case to TUKE Kosice.

The inclusion in the final rankings of candidates does not automatically entail the right to take a period of mobility, since the final decision rests with the host university, in this case with TUKE Kosice.
